We are happy to invite you to the 2025 Annual Congress **LET US SPEAK. Activist journalism in times of crisis and change**, which will be held in Kraków from the **15th** to the **20th of May**. Our aim is to deliver lectures and workshops on journalism that doesn't compromise - where reporters actively take part in events that shape reality. This covers a wide range of topics: from queer and women's rights, ecology to migration and the border crisis. At the AC, we want to explore activist journalism as a whole and discuss the moral dilemmas between journalistic integrity and activist influence on reality.

You will attend lectures led by experts in their fields, who will share their personal experiences and the challenges or threats that come with activist journalism.

This year's AC takes place in **Kraków**, one of the oldest and most culturally significant cities in Poland. During the event, you will have the chance to explore Kraków's historic Old Town (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), Wawel Castle, the Jewish district of Kazimierz, and much more on a guided tour. On one of the days, you will be given the opportunity to visit **Auschwitz-Birkenau**.

Seminars will be held at the **Jagiellonian University**, founded in 1364, making it one of the oldest universities in Europe. The exact venue of the lecures is Faculty of Management and Social Communication, located right next to picturesque Zakrzówek Quarry Lake, that you will also get to visit at the AC. Kraków is also known as Poland's 'student capital' due to its vibrant academic life, and luckily, you'll get a chance to experience it at its peak, as **juwenalia** (Polish student festivals) will coincide with our AC.

The Forum for European Journalism Students (FEJS) is an international nonprofit organization dedicated to the exchange of information between European Journalism students, young professionals and even citizens interested in the journalism field. The Forum attempts to bring such individuals together and promote interaction and networking while providing them with educational tools and framework to improve their knowledge and professional skills.

APPLICATION FORM

The application deadline is **March 31st**, **2025**. Please apply via <u>this link</u>. Due to the limited number of spots available, the application form includes a section where you must state your motivation for attending this year's AC in Kraków. This will allow the persons in charge to make an informed decision on the final selection of participants. You will be notified of your acceptance no later than **April 4th**, **2025**.

CQSTS

The participation fee for the event is **150 euros**, which covers food, accommodation and all the academic activities in the programme. **Your travel expenses will not be covered by this fee** – you have to take care of transportation to and from Kraków yourself. More information on payment requirements and bank account details will follow once you have been accepted to the event.

SQLIDARITY FUND

You can also apply for the **Solidarity Fund** via <u>this link</u>, which can cover up to **70%** of your travel expenses. Please submit your application by the deadline of **March 31st, 2025**, at the latest. Any applications submitted after this date will not be considered.

In return for receiving financial support from the Solidarity Fund, we ask you to contribute to the organization of the Annual Congress 2025. The application form includes a section where you can propose an idea for how you could assist the Organizing Committee (OC), for example, by suggesting a social media format you would like to implement during the AC.

The Solidarity Fund regularly gathers money at our events through the auction of gifts from country delegations, brought by participants. Once you get accepted for the AC, we will encourage you to choose something unique to your country to attract interest of other participants.
