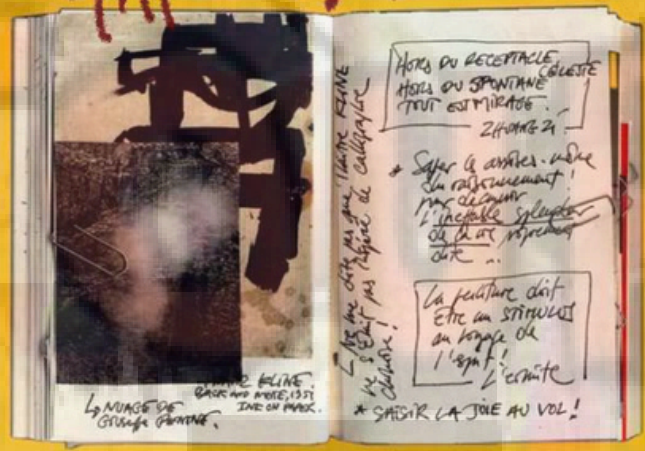

HEY YOU, LISTEN CLOSELY

We are happy to invite you to the 2025 Annual Congress **LET US SPEAK. Activist journalism in times of crisis and change**, which will be held in Kraków from the **15th** to the **20th of May**. Our aim is to deliver lectures and workshops on journalism that doesn't compromise - where reporters actively take part in events that shape reality. This covers a wide range of topics: from queer and women's rights, ecology to migration and the border crisis. At the AC, we want to explore activist journalism as a whole and discuss the moral dilemmas between journalistic integrity and activist influence on reality.

You will attend lectures led by experts in their fields, who will share their personal experiences and the challenges or threats that come with activist journalism.

This year's AC takes place in **Kraków**, one of the oldest and most culturally significant cities in Poland. During the event, you will have the chance to explore Kraków's historic Old Town (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), Wawel Castle, the Jewish district of Kazimierz, and much more on a guided tour. On one of the days, you will be given the opportunity to visit **Auschwitz-Birkenau**.

Seminars will be held at the **Jagiellonian University**, founded in 1364, making it one of the oldest universities in Europe. The exact venue of the lectures is Faculty of Management and Social Communication, located right next to picturesque Zakrzówek Quarry Lake, that you will also get to visit at the AC. Kraków is also known as Poland's 'student capital' due to its vibrant academic life, and luckily, you'll get a chance to experience it at its peak, as **juwenalia** (Polish student festivals) will coincide with our AC.

This will allow the persons in charge to make an informed decision on the final selection of participants. You will be notified of your acceptance no later than **April 4th, 2025**.

COSTS

The participation fee for the event is **150 euros**, which covers food, accommodation and all the academic activities in the programme. **Your travel expenses will not be covered by this fee** – you have to take care of transportation to and from Kraków yourself. More information on payment requirements and bank account details will follow once you have been accepted to the event.

Murthy wreck Kerala

for an additional 29 runs and Karnataka, in reply, ended the day at 97 without loss here at the Chinnaswamy Stadium.

Kerala's poor batting, reflected well enough in their total of 132, has now given Karnataka a fine opportunity in going for an innings win, specially after the rousing start they got through Shyamchandra Bhat (batting 50) and young J. Arunkumar (batting 46). And it looks like only the weather gods can disrupt Karnataka's plans en route to defending the title as the new rule does not permit the covering of the wicket.

But as was feared yesterday afternoon, it rained quite a bit in the afternoon and evening, today's play did not get delayed. R. Muralidhar exploited the morning conditions by bowling a fine line and length but partner David Johnson was less aggressive comparatively. The team bowlers, however, were short of the expected batsmen who went in for 87 for three.

tourists had got off to a bad opening opener Ittycheria who was on edge to keep his wicket in matches besides cricket. Kamaruddeen (43) and the batsmen for the second wicket turned out to be disappointing. The former was caught into the hands of Arunkumar

There was no resistance by any of the Kerala batsman afterwards except for vice-captain Sunil Kumar's purposeful 34, as they folded up seven minutes before tea, finding David Johnson and leg spinner Srinivas Murthy too hot to handle. Johnson bowled intelligently in his second spell. He finished with figures of five for 46 while Murthy recorded magical figures of 13-7-13-3.

Both the Karnataka openers were at ease against the Kerala bowlers who are not that familiar playing on a turf wicket.
